Christmas in England

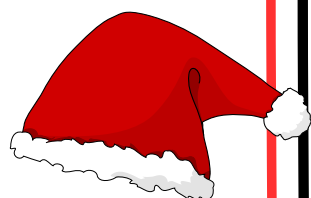
In England, they don't celebrate Christmas on December 24th. They celebrate it on December 25th instead.

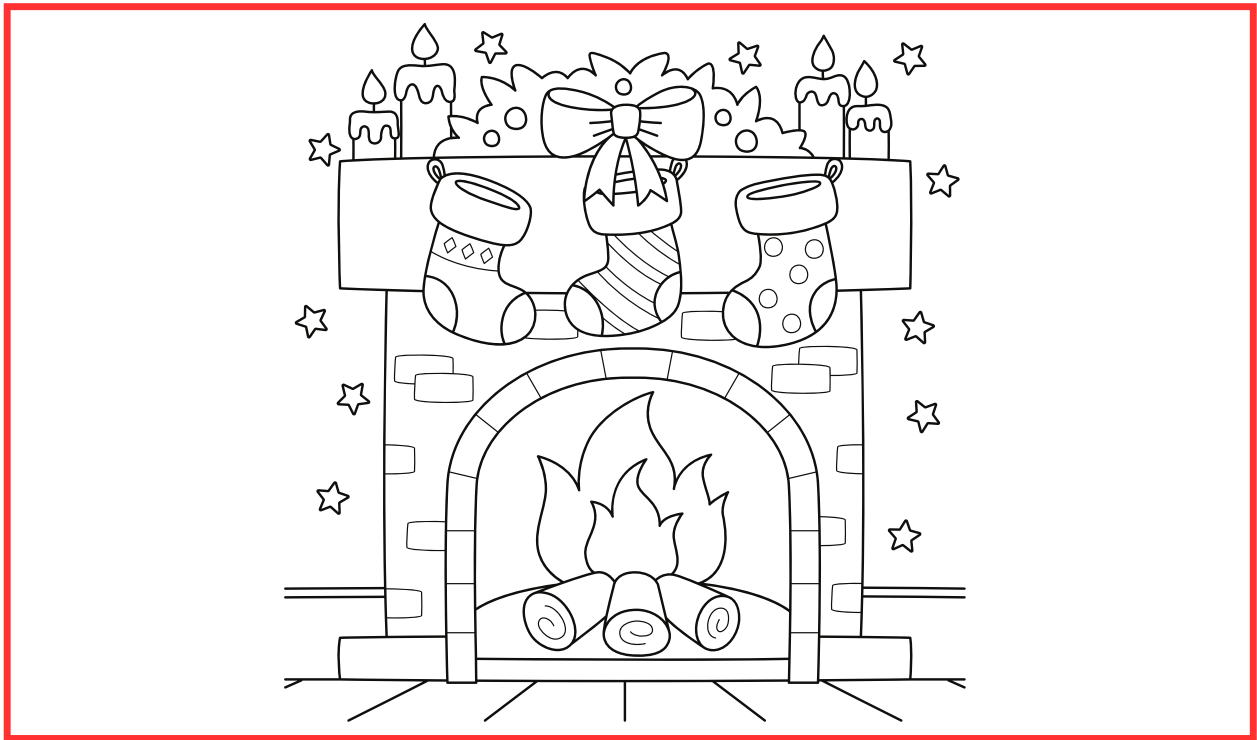
